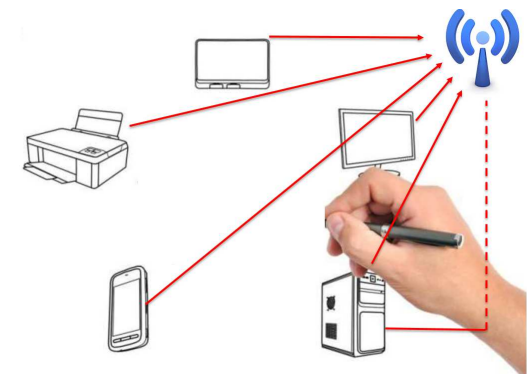
Plan your WLAN network before you arrive

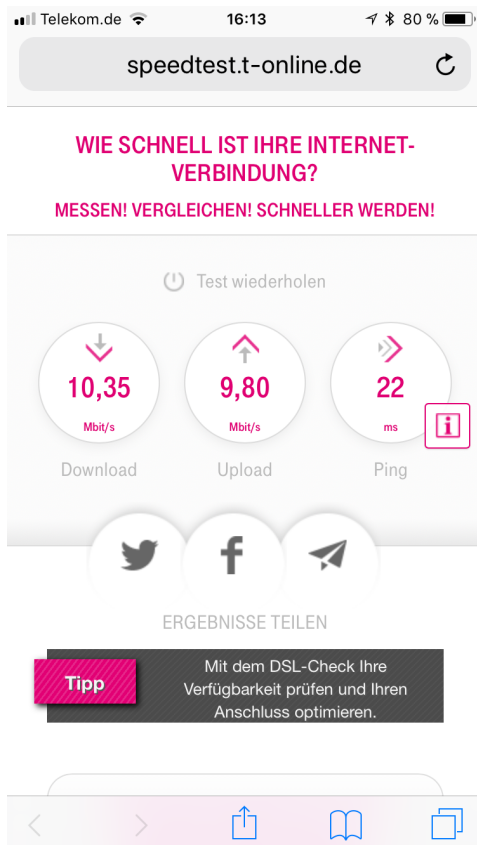

Business HOTSPOT for exhibitors

As an exhibitor, you will have your own network, a business HOTSPOT, set up especially for exhibitors.

Get your access details from Deutsche Telekom at Messe Düsseldorf.

Our WLAN means you can upload and download data at a speed of 10Mbits/s.



- Keep costs down by using our own Business HOTSPOTS.
- With our standard business package, up to 10 users can access the internet at any one time. If you like, you can increase this to 25, 50 or 100.
- The devices you use must support a **5 Ghz frequency**.
- You are not permitted to set up your own access points.
